HAEMOWAX Sterile Bone Wax

DESCRIPTION

HAEMOWAX - Bone Wax is a sterile mixture of Purified White Beeswax, Hard Paraffin, Isopropyl Palmitate

INTENDED USE

It is used to control local bleeding from bone surfaces by creating a mechanical (tamponade) barrier. Bone wax is supplied sterile in 2.5 gram in all foil envelopes with sealed overwraps. Packets should be opened just prior to use to minimize the possibility of contamination and excessive drying and should be used immediately. Bone wax should not be resterilized or subjected to excessive heat.

Color:	Opaque
Absorption:	Minimally resorbable
Sterilization:	Gamma Radiation
Product Characteristics:	Helps local haemostasis by functioning like a mechanical barrier & is biochemically inert
Packaging:	In aluminium foil packages
